

Siúlóidí Lúb an Phollaigh Pollagh Loop Walks



Tosaíonn an dá shiúlóid sa charrchlós in aice le hEaglais Naomh Muire. Tabhair cuairt ar an séipéal a bhfuil cruth thar a bheith uathúil air. Breathnaigh le haoibhneas ar na fuinneoga áille ó stiúideo Harry Clarke agus ar an áltóir d'íúr portaigh dealbhaithe ag Michael Casey. In aice na heaglaise tá Droichead Phluincéid a tógadh sa bhliain 1809. Tá cruth ar leith ar an droichead, cosúil le 'n', rud a chiallaíonn go mbíonn ar an tiománaí dhá ghéarchasadh a dhéanamh ag buaic an droichid.

Tá an ceantar taobh leis an gcanáil forbartha le hárdán murála do na báid agus cosán a théann chomh fada leis an teach tabhairne, "The Pull Inn". Táimid an-cheanúil ar ár ndealbhóireacht "Fear an Phortaigh", a léiríonn an nasc

stairiúil le baint na móna sa cheantar. Tá an tóir ata ar an gcanáil ag méadú gach bhliain.

Chun tús a chur leis na siúlóidí buail leat thar an droichead agus tóg an tslí chle taobh leis an gcanáil. Agus tú ag siúl ar bhruach na canála rachaidh tú thar suiomh iarchlóis bhricí agus is féidir leat léamh faoi stair ne mbricí máguaird. Nuair a thógann tú casadh ar dheis fágann tú an canáil taobh thiar díot agus tagann tú ar bóthar gairbhéil áit a bhfuil pointe eolais faoi portaigh árdaithe i lá na tíre. Ag an gcéad achomhal eile scarann an tsiúlóid ghorm agus an tsiúlóid chorcra. Cibé ceann a thógann tú is féidir leat dul ar ais go dtí an sráidbhaile ag trasnú Droichead Phluincéid ag filleadh ar an gcarrchlós.

Both walks start in the carpark at St. Mary's Church.

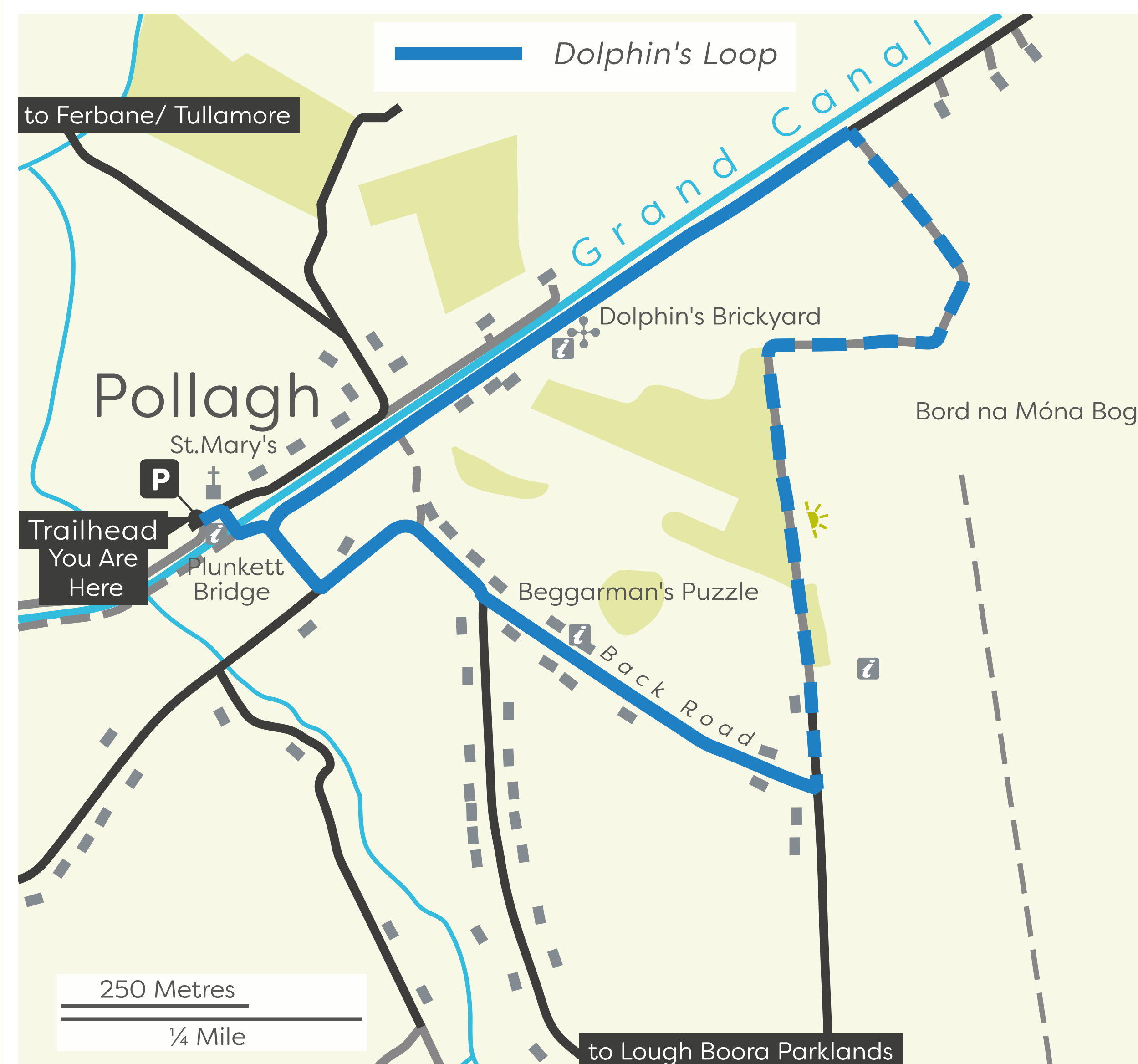
Pay a visit to the church which is particularly unique in design. Admire the beautiful windows from the Harry Clarke studios and the bog yew altar sculpted by Michael Casey. Beside the church is Plunkett Bridge. Built in 1809, it's peculiar shape resembles an "n" meaning the driver must make two sharp turns at the peak of the bridge.



The area alongside the canal has been developed to include a mooring platform for boats and a walkway as

far as the Pull Inn pub. We are particularly fond of our "Bogman" sculpture, representing the strong history of turf cutting in the area. The canal is increasing in popularity every year.

To start both walks head over Plunkett Bridge and take the left route alongside the canal. As you walk along the canal bank you will pass by the location of a former brickyard where you can read about the history of brickmaking in the area. When you take a right turn, leaving the canal, you come on to a gravel road, passing the information point on raised bogs in the Midlands. At the next junction the Blue and Purple walks divide. Both options take you back to the village, crossing Plunkett Bridge to the carpark.
